# Poured In Place Safety Surfacing

### Manufacturer's Specifications

This document provides the specifications for a poured in place safety surfacing system composed of a wearing layer upper membrane and an underlying impact attenuation custion layer.

# PART 1 - GENERAL

Provide all labor, materials, and tools necessary for the complete installation of a poured in place safety surfacing system as outlined in these specifications. The system shall consist of but not necessarily be limited to the followin

- Section includes. Resilient playground surfacing powerd-in-place system
   Related work: Playground equipment and resilient playground surfacing sub-base
- Quality Assurance: Manufacturer shall have manufactured and installed playground poured-in-place (afet surfaces for a minimum of 3 years, and meet current ASTM F 1292-09 Test Circeia. The installation of the poured-in place product shall be completed by FLSMRQUIN, LLC Manufacturer's detailed installation procedures shall be submitted to the Architect and made part of the Bid Specifications.

- b. The installer must provide competent workmen skilled in this specific type of poured in place safety sorfacing outern installation. The designated supervisory personnel on the project must be compete the installation of this material, including mining of the materials, and spreading and compacting the materials, correctly.
- entertains currecup: matablation should be in accordance with ASTM F3292-09 for Impact Attenuation of surface system un and around playground equipment. The pound-in-place system to be installed in compliance with the Critical Fall Medica as determined by the Playground Equipment to be installed in conjunction with the pource-in-place surfacing system.
- Product must be manufactured and installed by an entity or company wholly owned and oper Arizona based principals. Such requirement shall extend to any "parent" company or entity
- Manufacturer should provide written instructions for recommended maintenance practices.
- f. Manufacturer should submit color samples for customer verification.

### PART 2 - ENDURAFIEK MATERIAL

- d. The ENDURAFLEX wearing surface should be manufactured from 1.3 mm Thermoplastic Vulcanized (TF virgin colored rubber mixed with alighatic urethang binder (110 pounds of TFV to 22 pounds of binder).
- g. The system color should be selected from Manufacturer's Color Chart by owner prior to bid.

The ENDURAFLEX site preparation and base shall be in accordance with the following

- a. The sub-base will have a slope of 0.2%.

The poured in place safety surfacing installer shall strictly achieve to the installations procedures outlined under these sections. Any variance from these requirements shall be accepted in writing by the manufacturer's constant propresentative, and submitted to the architectrollener, enviringing that the changes do not in any way affect the warranty.

- a. A unethane primer should be applied to concrete, asphalt or wood surfaces at a rate of 200-150 square feet per gallon. The orders area does not need to be primed at once, instead, prime about 700 square feet at a time. This procedure should be continued until all areas are compiled.
- a. The urethane primer should be applied to any playground equipment that will be currounded by the anured in place safety surfacing system.

a The components of the poured in place safety surfacing shools be mixed on site in a mixer to ensure a comprehensive mix according to manufacturer's instructions.





CHART REPRESENTS THE TOTAL (SBR CUSHION AND TPV WEAR COURSE) SYSTEM DEPTH
