In 1941, the name of the school was changed to the NYS Agricultural and Technical Institute. On April 1, 1948, the lighting became a part of the newly formed State University of New York. The granting of the Associate in Applied Science degree was inaugurated in June 1951, as a result of this new association. In the fall of 1964, the name of the School was changed to State University of New York Agricultural and Technical College at Alfred, NY. The degree of Associate in Science was first granted in 1967; the degree of Associate in Arts in 1972, the degree of Associate in Occupational Studies in 1973. In 1987 the official name of the college was changed to State University of New York College of Technology at Alfred, Informally the college is known as Alfred State College or Alfred State. Beginning in 1991 the College began to confer bachelor's degrees including the degrees of Bachelor of Science (BS), Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) and Bachelor of Architecture (BARCH) in a number of programs.

The College is regionally accredited by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education.

The graduation requirements for all students who entered prior to June 15, 1966 are 99-quarter credit hours and 198 honor points based on a 4.00 index system (99 honor points on a 3.00 index system). All students who entered after June 15, 1966 and prior to June 1974 must have carried a minimum of 90-quarter credit hours with a 2.00 cumulative index based on a 4.00 index system. Students who entered after June 1974 are required to have 60 credit hours for an associate's degree and 120 credit hours for a backelor's degree with a 2.00 cumulative index hased on a 4.00 index system.

Prior to September 1951, the College operated on the basis of two semesters, each about 16 weeks in duration. From 1951 through 1973, the College academic year was composed of three quarters, each about 11 weeks in duration. In June 1974, the College returned to a two-semester being approximately 15 weeks in duration.

- 1. Each certificate of registration expires on June 30 next following the date of issuance.
- 2. A certificate of registration may be renewed for 1 year from each succeeding July 1, upon submission of:
 - (a) The annual renewal fee prescribed by the Board pursuant to the provisions of NRS 623A.240;
- (b) Proof of compliance with the requirements established by the Board for continuing education for the renewal of the certificate of registration; and
 - (c) All information required to complete the renewal.
- 3. A certificate of registration that has expired through failure to be renewed may be renewed at any time within 1 year after the date of its expiration upon application to and with the approval of the Board and upon payment of the annual renewal fee and the delinquency fee prescribed by the Board pursuant to the provisions of NRS 623A.240.
- 4. A certificate of registration that has expired for failure to be renewed within 1 year after the date of its expiration may be reinstated by the Board without examination within 3 years after the date the certificate of registration expires upon application to and with the approval of the Board and upon payment of:
- (a) The annual renewal fee for each year, or part thereof, the certificate of registration is not renewed;

- (b) The delinquency fee; and
- (c) The reinstatement fee.
- 5. If a holder of a certificate of registration submits to the Board the annual renewal fee, proof and information required pursuant to the provisions of subsection 2, or if the Board approves the renewal or reinstatement of a certificate of registration pursuant to the provisions of subsection 3 or 4, the Executive Director of the Board shall, upon receipt of the applicable fees, proof and information or upon receipt of the approval of the Board, issue a renewal card to the applicant, indicating that the certificate of registration is renewed for 1 year. The renewal card must bear the seal of the Board and include:
 - (a) The number of the certificate of registration; and
 - (b) The signature of the President or Executive Director of the Board or a facsimile of that signature.

Legislative Session Guidance

The 82nd Session of the Nevada Legislature will begin on February 6, 2023. The Office of the Attorney General (OAG) offers the following guidance to Nevada State Agency Public Bodies (Boards and Commissions) regarding their activities during the Legislative Session.

Boards and Commissions are subject to Nevada's Open Meeting laws, Nevada's Ethics in Government laws, and Nevada's laws regarding lobbying, NRS Chapters 241, 281A and 218H, respectively. The general guidance provided below is intended to assist Board and Commission members and staff in the performance of their duties during legislative session. However, this general guidance does not alter or supersede existing law, regulation or precedent and is not an official attorney general opinion. It is not a substitute for legal advice from the Board or Commission's own legal counsel. Board and Commission members should consult with their legal counsel if they have any questions or concerns regarding their activities.

Board and Commission members may not appear **on behalf of** their Board or Commission in front of the Legislature unless specifically authorized to do so during a public meeting. NRS 241.015(1). Action is required to delegate any authority to a single member of the Board or Commission and that action must comply with the Open Meeting Law (OML) to be effective. It is advised that Boards and Commissions provide as much direction in their delegation as possible so that they do not have to take action prior to every appearance by the member. Alternatively, Executive Directors, agency heads or their designees may appear before the legislature without authorization to explain the effect of legislation or any other legislative action related to their departments, divisions or agencies.

The Nevada Legislature is exempt from the OML, including its required three working day notice for meetings. NRS 241.016(2)(a). The pace of the legislative session is variable and proposed amendments to legislation may occur at a pace that does not allow a public body to consider and opine on each and every proposed amendment or bill

draft request. Hearing scheduling or requests from the Legislature generally do not qualify as an emergency under NRS 241.020(11) allowing for a public meeting on shorter notice. Thus, Boards and Commissions should consider delegating authority to a member or staff member to speak on the Board or Commission's behalf in advance if they anticipate relevant Legislative hearings may be scheduled. The OAG recommends considering potential issues and positions when making such a delegation as opposed to single pieces of legislation. Boards and Commissions may also consider what sort of legislative updates they desire from their staff or delegated members and schedule meetings appropriately.

Boards and Commissions should also take care in the level detail that is included in an agenda where action on specific legislation is to be considered. "[T]o the extent that a public body plans to affirmatively take a position on specific legislation, the public body should list the bill or topic of legislation on its agenda so that the public is aware that possible action may take place. The OAG notes that reference to a specific piece of legislation may not be necessary where the agenda provides sufficient notice regarding the legislative topic or issue that the public body intends to take a position on."

In addition, members and employees of Boards and Commissions may only explain the effect of legislation or any other legislative action related to their departments, divisions or agencies and otherwise provide information to the legislature. Advocating for or against any particular legislation would be considered lobbying and registration as a lobbyist may be required. NRS 218H.080(2).

Board or Commission members may always appear in front of the Legislature on their own behalf and may identify their relationship to a Board or Commission but must specify that they are **not speaking for** the Board or Commission. Board and Commission members must comply with their ethical responsibilities as public officers under NRS Chapter 281A regardless of who they are representing in front of the legislature.

Informational Report – Executive Order 2023-003

Pursuant to Executive Order 2023-003, a report must be submitted with the following information:

Section 1 - Comprehensive Review of Regulations

Every executive branch department, agency, board and commission shall undertake a comprehensive review of the regulations subject to its enforcement. On or before, May 1, 2023 each department, agency, board and commission shall provide a report to the Governor's office detailing how the regulation subject to its enforcement can be streamlined, clarified, reduced or otherwise improved to ensure those regulations provide for the general welfare of the State without unnecessarily inhibiting economic growth.

The report must include for **each** regulation identified in the comprehensive review that can be streamlined, clarified, reduced, or otherwise improved to ensure that the regulation provide for the general welfare of the State without unnecessarily inhibiting economic growth:

- 1. The citation of the regulation with clear indication of the proposed modification in blue italics and matters to be omitted in red and bracketed.
- 2. A clear and concise explanation on why such change should occur.
- 3. Information for each public meeting held to discuss the proposed regulation change, as mandated by Section 3 of Executive Order 2023-003, which must include:
 - a. The date of the meeting(s) and number of persons who attended;
 - b. Information for each person who provided public oral or written comment or testimony on the regulation:
 - i. Name of person;
 - ii. Name of entity or organization represented and address (if applicable);
 - iii. Contact telephone number;
 - iv. Electronic mail address; and
 - c. A summary of each person's public oral or written comment or testimony.
- 4. The estimated impact on any business, person, or agency if the change is to occur, which must include:
 - a. The adverse and beneficial effects;
 - b. The positive or negative economic impact; and
 - c. Cost savings to the state or agency.
- 5. In the event your agency has sufficient justification for an exemption to this Executive Order, as described below and in Section 5, please submit a list of requests for any such exemption to dktedford@gov.nv.gov. Qualifying purposes for an exemption include:
 - a. Regulations that affect public health;
 - b. Regulations that affect public safety and security;
 - c. Regulations that are necessary in the pursuit of federal funds and certifications;
 - d. Regulations that affect the application of powers, functions and duties essential to the operation of the executive branch agency, department, board or commission at issue;
 - e. Regulations that affect pending judicial deadlines; and
 - f. Regulations necessary to comply with federal law.

Section 2 – Regulation for Removal

As part of its report, every executive branch department, agency, board and commission shall provide a list of not less than ten (10) regulations recommended for removal, ranking them in descending order of priority.

The report must include for **each** of the ten (10) regulations recommended for removal (ranked in descending order of priority):

- 1. The citation of the regulation with matters to be omitted in red and bracketed.
- 2. A clear and concise explanation of the need for the elimination of the regulation.
- 3. Information for each public meeting held to discuss the proposed regulation elimination, as mandated by Section 3 of Executive Order 2023-003, which must include:
 - a. The date of the meeting(s) and the number of persons who attended;
 - b. Information for each person who provided public oral or written comment or testimony on the regulation:
 - i. Name of person;
 - ii. Name of entity or organization represented and address (if applicable);
 - iii. Contact telephone number;
 - iv. Electronic mail address; and
 - c. A summary of each person's public oral or written comment or testimony.
- 4. The estimated impact on any business, person, or agency if the change is to occur, which must include:

- a. The adverse and beneficial effects;
- b. The positive or negative economic impact; and
- c. Cost savings to the state or agency.

Section 3 - Mandatory Meeting and Report

Prior to submitting their respective reports, every executive branch department, agency, board and commission shall hold a public hearing, after having provided reasonable notice consistent with Chapter 233B of the Nevada Revised Statutes, to key industry stakeholders, to: (i) vet their recommended changes; (ii) solicit input as to the merits of those changes and (iii) identify other regulatory changes stakeholders feel are worthy of consideration. Stakeholder input shall be reflected in the summary of findings and recommendations included in each submitted report.

Executive Order 2023-03 - Template
